Proverbs 3: 5-6

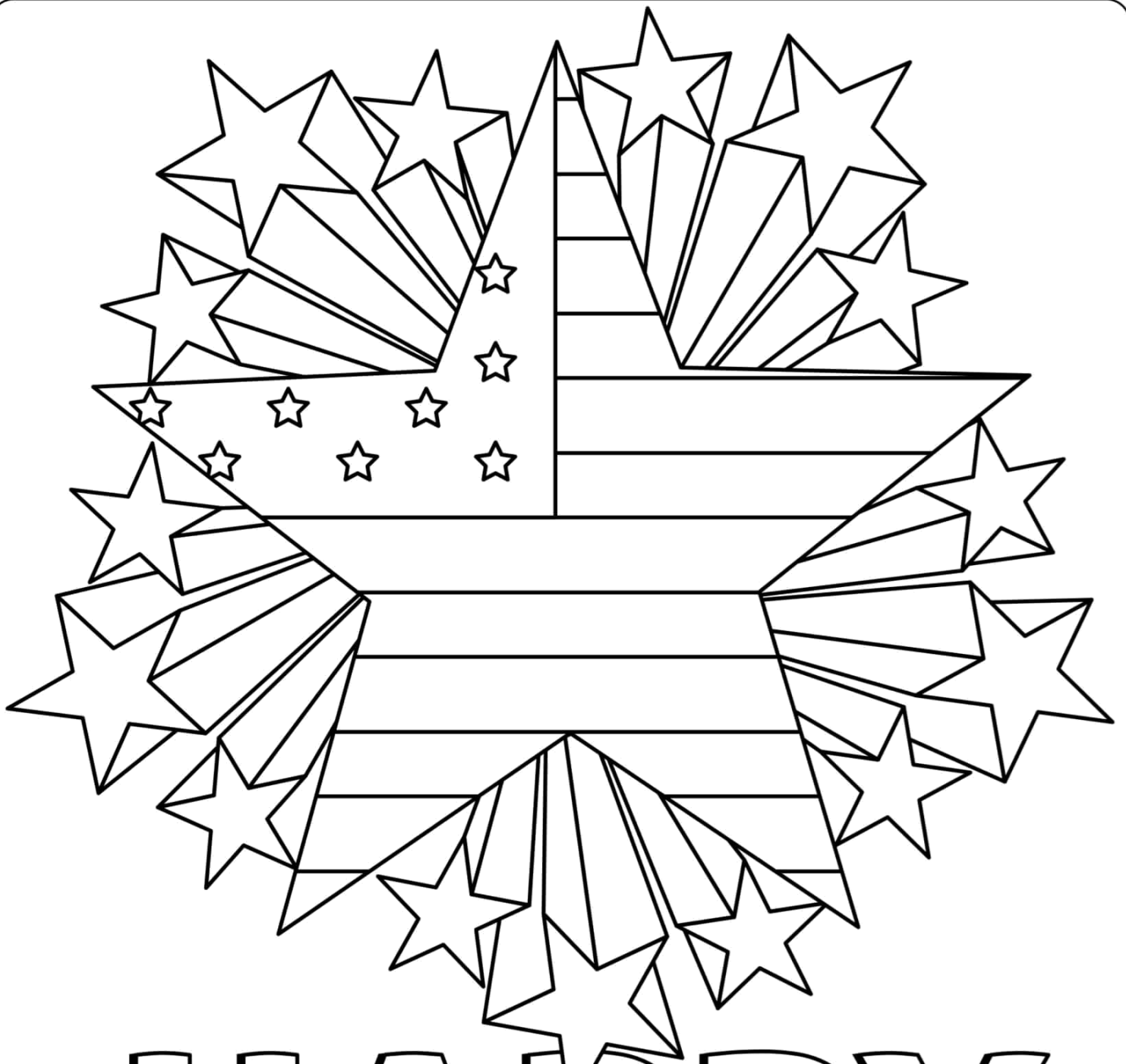


Healthcare Corner
